It is used in the microcosm of municipality, day-care facility and school.

Neustart gGmbH

“*Neustart gGmbH*” [association restart] is responsible for the implementation of the probation service, court assistance and victim-offender mediation in Baden-Württemberg.

No 68

Niedersächsisches Ministerium für Inneres und Sport

“White IT – alliance for children” is an association aimed at contributing to the fight against child abuse and its representation. Technical as well as social methods and strategies should be determined, evaluated and implemented.

No 135

Oberzent-Schule Beerfelden

The school of Beerfelden will present its “*Mediencoachprojekt*” [media coach project] which is a peer project aimed at instructing pupils of secondary education in dealing with new media. The pupils are trained by various project partners so as to improve their media competency and be able to help younger pupils with their problems.

No 118

Odenwald-Regional-Gesellschaft (OREG)mbH

The “*Odenwald-Regional-Gesellschaft (OREG)mbH*” [Odenwald regional subsidiary], the police department Odenwald and the Odenwald public transport companies have cooperatively trained voluntary bus- and train attendants since 2004. These voluntary helpers are pupils from grade 8 onwards who are educated by qualified trainers in a professional training lasting several days.

No 117

Ortspolizeibehörde Bremerhaven

The “*Ortspolizeibehörde Bremerhaven*” [local police office Bremerhaven] is the last municipal office in the Federal Republic of Germany which is autonomously responsible for the assessment of police tasks. It will present a chosen number of crime and traffic preventive measures from 2013.

No 155

Papilio e.V.

“*Papilio*” is a programme for kindergartens which is aimed at enhancing socio-emotional competencies and thereby preventing a development of addiction and violence. “*Papilio*” reduces early behavioural problems and thus prevents addiction and violence in adolescence.

No 9

PHINEO gAG

The non-profit organisation “*PHINEO gAG*” developed a guide under the headline “*KURSBUCH WIRKUNG*” [Guide Effect] which informs about effect-oriented working and planning strategies in prevention projects. With a number of easily understandable illustrations, proper advice and a practical example, it moreover demonstrates how to analyse the effects of preventive projects.

Polizei Sachsen

The “*Landeskriminalamt Sachsen*” [State Office of Criminal Investigations] and the “*Handwerkskammer Dresden*” [Chamber of Crafts Dresden] jointly developed the prevention programme “*Sicheres Handwerk*” [Safe Handcraft] which is particularly concerned with a preventive fight against robbery in craft businesses in Sachsen.

The police of the Rems-Murr-district provides an advice centre connected to the criminal investigation department that has been available to all citizens needing advice and support since 1987. Since 2007, the “*Haus der Prävention*” [house of prevention] has provided a wide range of offers regarding prevention in the field of traffic and crime for individuals, schools, networks and a great number of other sections of the population.

No 63

Polizeipräsidium Bochum – Kriminalprävention

“*Senioren-sicherheitsberater*” [voluntary workers advising elderly people on safety issues] trained by the police headquarters of Bochum will present the “*Senioren-sicherheitsprojekt*” [project on the safety of elderly people] and their work. Main focus of the work lies on criminal acts to the detriment of elderly people.

No 147

Polizeipräsidium Heilbronn

The “*Polizeipräsidium Heilbronn*” [police headquarters of Heilbronn] will present its new prevention structure with a responsibility for four districts, its cooperation with prevention associations and a number of chosen projects on current topics.

No 65

Polizeipräsidium Karlsruhe, Haus des Jugendrechts Pforzheim und Enzkreis – “Anti-Graffiti-Mobil”

In the “*Haus des Jugendrechts*” [house of juvenile justice], police, prosecution and the “*Bezirksverein für soziale Rechtspflege*” [county union for the social administration of justice] jointly work together. The project “*Junge Fahrer – gib Deinem Schutzengel eine Chance*” [Young drivers – give your guardian angel a chance] has been initiated by the Pforzheim-Enzkreis in 2008. The guardian-angel concept relies on the influence of the peer group – voluntary participants are informed about the impact of drugs, alcohol and the main causes of traffic accidents and are thereby qualified as ‘guardian angels’ who may exert direct influence on the potential driver on the spot.

No 79

Polizeipräsidium Ludwigsburg / Referat Prävention

The project “*Mit Spaß und Spiel gegen Drogen und Gewalt*” [Fun and game against drugs and violence] considers the fact that the social behaviour of children and adolescents is strongly oriented at role models. Since sportsmen and football players in particular exert an important exemplary function, the “*VfB Stuttgart*” [football club of Stuttgart] actively participates in the project in order to positively influence the thinking and behaviour of children and adolescents with respect to violence and/or the consumption of drugs.

No 83

Prävention im Blick – im Landkreis Diepholz

The project “*Bürgermut tut allen gut – Nachbarschaften gegen Häusliche Gewalt*” [Civil courage is beneficial for everyone – neighbourhoods against domestic violence] will be presented. What is special about this project is that it directly addresses the civilian population in the rural area and thereby aims at a sensitising them and strengthening their own ability to take action when it comes to dealing with domestic violence.

Instead of an imprisonment, the adolescents absolve a temporary training programme that is specifically designed for them.

No 85

Rat für Kriminalitätsverhütung Schleswig-Holstein (RfK)

The “*Rat für Kriminalitätsverhütung Schleswig-Holstein*” [council of crime prevention of Schleswig-Holstein] has been established in 1990 in order to contribute to the reduction of crime and its effects in Schleswig-Holstein via the establishment of a network of governmental and non-governmental organisations and institutions. Moreover, the factual security situation as well as the citizen’s subjective sense of security should thereby be enhanced.

No 153

Regiestelle TOLERANZ FÖRDERN – KOMPETENZ STÄRKEN und Initiative Demokratie Stärken / BIKnetz – Präventionsnetz gegen Rechtsextremismus

“*TOLERANZ FÖRDERN – KOMPETENZ STÄRKEN*” [Encourage tolerance – reinforce competence] supports projects for tolerance and democracy and against right-wing extremism. “*Initiative Demokratie Stärken*” [initiative reinforcing democracy] is a preventive programme against left-wing extremism and Islamic extremism. “*BIK-netz – Präventionsnetz gegen Rechtsextremismus*” [BIK-net – prevention network against right-wing extremism] is a nationwide information and competence network for the support of preventive pedagogical work against right-wing extremism.

No 14

Rheinisches Präventionsinstitut gegen Gewalt

The interdisciplinary institute is concerned with the following tasks: research in the field of prevention regarding protection concepts against social, domestic and sexual violence; expert talks on the topic; prevention trainings against social, domestic and sexual violence; establishment of a network with European prevention partners.

No 154

Schillerschule Brühl / Baden

The “*Schillerschule Brühl / Baden*” [school of Brühl/Baden] has been teaching the special subject “*TrosT – EIN REDESTABRITUAL*” [consolation – a ritual with a talking stick] that is aimed at effective prevention work since 2009/10.

No 24

SDNA Technology GmbH

SDNA is part of a consortium located in Schriesheim near Heidelberg which started to make prominent high-value marking products including artificial DNA (kDNA) under the trade name SelectaDNA, SelectaMark and Microdust as a prevention strategy in the fight against theft and robbery in Germany at the end of 2009.

No 53

Seehaus e.V.

The project “*Seehaus e.V.*” [Lake house] offers an alternative to the conventional penal system – remote from prison walls and the negative influence of other prisoners. Adolescent offenders willing to refine themselves may apply for the project and may, with the approval of the prison director, spend their prison term within the project.

No 60

Sicheres Freiburg e.V.

The association “*Sicheres Freiburg e.V.*” [Safe Freiburg] has been founded on the instigation of the “*Freiburger Koordinationsrat Kommunale Kriminalprävention*” [municipal crime prevention coordination council of Freiburg] in 2002. Since then, the association has prompted and implemented a great number of projects particularly aimed at crime prevention and the encouragement of civil courage.

No 70

SKM – Katholischer Verein für soziale Dienste in der Erzdiözese Freiburg e.V.

The “*SKM – Katholischer Verein für soziale Dienste in der Erzdiözese Freiburg e.V.*” [SKM – Catholic association for social services in the archdiocese of Freiburg] is an umbrella organisation comprising 14 “*SKM-Vereine*” [association for social services for Catholic men] which are engaged in offender support and assistance to the homeless.

No 73

Stadt Esslingen in Kooperation mit dem Polizeirevier Esslingen

The project “*Wilde Pause*” [Wild break] allows children from age three to 13 to scramble, struggle and wrestle during their break. Being supervised by a pedagogue or teacher, the children learn to realistically estimate themselves in a playful way. Thereby, prejudices and fears of contacts are reduced, frustration tolerance and empathy are enhanced and aggression is dissipated.

No 75

Stadt Karlsruhe

Prevention is an important topic for the municipality of Karlsruhe: Many offices are engaged in preventing violence, racism and drug abuse via counseling services and a variety of projects. The city will together with its partners inform about this engagement.

Stadt Karlsruhe – Kulturbüro

The “*Kulturbüro Karlsruhe*” [cultural office of Karlsruhe] presents two types of events annually realised with a number of partners in Karlsruhe; firstly, the “*Karlsruher Wochen gegen Rassismus*” [Weeks against racism in Karlsruhe] and secondly “*KiX+JuX – Das Kulturfestival der Kinder und Jugendlichen*” [Culture festival for children and adolescents].

Stadt Karlsruhe Gleichstellungsbüro ZJD

The “*Gleichstellungsbüro ZJD*” [office for equal opportunities] presents information on the project “*Häusliche Gewalt überwinden*” [Defeating domestic violence].

Stadt Karlsruhe, Sozial- und Jugendbehörde / Hauptabteilung Beratung

The municipal counseling and advice centres of Karlsruhe will present a number of chosen core themes and projects, e.g. burnout prevention concepts for employees and the project “*Jugendschutz Karlsruhe*” [Youth protection Karlsruhe] initiated by the addiction prevention division.

Schwarzwaldhalle

Stadt Karlsruhe, Sozial- und Jugendbehörde / Jugendgerichtshilfe

“*STEP – Verein zur Förderung von Erziehung und Bildung e.V.*” [STEP – Association for the support of upbringing and education] is among others concerned with a material and immaterial support of nationwide projects promoting a partnership in the field of education via the programme STEP.

Stiftung Opferhilfe Niedersachsen

The “*Stiftung Opferhilfe Niedersachsen*” [foundation under public law for victim support in Lower Saxony] was founded in 2001 by the Federal Government of Lower Saxony. Specially trained family attendants visited the families from the time of pregnancy until the child's second birthday. Accompanying research with a control group evaluated the pilot project.

Täter-Opfer-Ausgleich im Justizvollzug und LAG TOA Baden-Württemberg

The project “*TOA im Justizvollzug*” [victim-offender mediation in law enforcement] establishes the possibility for a clarifying communication between victim, perpetrator and their respective relatives and as far as possible for a compensation.

No 58

theaterpädagogische werkstatt gGmbH

The “*theaterpädagogische Werkstatt gGmbH*” [theatre education workshop] has developed prevention programmes on the topics of sexual abuse, addiction, violence, right-wing extremism, civil courage and general concerns about education since 1994.

No 125

Triple P Deutschland GmbH

“*Liebend gern erziehen mit Triple P*” [Educating with affection with Triple P] is a scientifically valid and prevention-oriented approach aimed at strengthening child-raising competencies and further competencies regarding the establishment of parental relationships.

No 28

Unfallkasse Baden-Württemberg

The “*Unfallkasse Baden-Württemberg*” [accident insurance company of Baden-Württemberg] is statutory accident insurance institution for the municipalities and the federal state of Baden-Württemberg. All employees working for municipal or governmental institutions, as well as kindergarten children, pupils and students rank among the company’s insurants.

No 43

Universität Erlangen – EFFEKT

“*EFFEKT: Entwicklungsförderung in Familien: Eltern- und KinderTraining*” [Development support in families: training for parents and children] consists of a behavioural training for parents and a social-cognitive training for children. The trainings are targeted at emotionally charged families.

Verein Programm Klasse2000 e.V.

“*Klasse2000 e.V.*” [Class2000] is the nationally most widespread programme aimed at health promotion as well as at violence and addiction prevention at primary schools. 18.300 classes with more than 420.000 pupils from all federal states participated in the programme in 2012/13.

No 40

Verein zur Förderung der Methode Puppenspiel in der Kriminal- und Verkehrsprävention e.V. (VPKV)

The puppet show is a scientifically proven method in the field of crime and traffic prevention. The puppet theatre is nationally mostly applied by police officers who have joined together in the “*Verein zur Förderung der Methode des Puppenspiels in der Kriminal- und Verkehrsprävention e.V.*” [association for the promotion of the method of the puppet show in crime and traffic prevention].

No 149

Verkehrsbetriebe Karlsruhe GmbH (VBK)

The programme “*Zusammenhalt durch Teilhabe*” [Solidarity through participation] initiated by the Federal Ministry of the Interior promotes a confident, vivid and democratic community culture in rural and structurally weak areas.
